***"I ain't gonna work for you no more" declares the opener to Brynovsky's third studio album. Dub pop producer Tim Jones now goes solo, taking on the lead vocal along with all other duties.***

*Future Weather* steers a committed line through political pop and reflective mantra to thickly-layered dub tones and harmonies. Lyrical themes are drawn from the personal to political, reflecting upon inequality, climate change, populism, and the rise of the Right.

The mood is more radical than *Time Is Now* (2014) and while the rich vocal harmonies remain, the sound is more intense and raw, mixing the anarchic with the electronic and the melodic with the acoustic.

Tim's songcraft is on the ascendancy and his bass-driven dub pop frequently gives way to a more reflective tone contributing to an electronic acoustic dance of dub-rock balladry. Out in November 2020.
